

Ockbrook & Borrowash Cricket Club 100 Club – Terms and Conditions

- 1. The name of the draw is 'Ockbrook & Borrowash Cricket 100 Club' regardless of the number of members. Hereafter referred to as 'OBCC 100 Club'.
- 2. The objective of the OBCC 100 Club is to raise funds for the general purpose of Ockbrook & Borrowash Cricket Club.
- 3. The OBCC 100 Club will be administered by the 'OBCC 100 Club Administrator' appointed by the OBCC Main Committee. Applications to join the 100 Club shall be made to the OBCC 100 Club Administrator and can be applied for in writing or electronically. If registration is made electronically it is deemed that participants using this method agree to the 100 Club rules. All members must agree to their details being kept on computer.
- 4. The subscription to the 100 Club for one number/share shall be £60 per year payable annually in advance. This will give members one number which will be placed in 12 monthly draws (i.e. cost is £5.00 per month). Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
- 5. The 100 club is open for all members (playing or social) of OBCC and their family and friends. All members must be over 16 years of age. The more shares/numbers we sell, the bigger the prizes!
- 6. There is no provision to opt in/out on a month by month basis. The normal 100 club year will be May to April. Members joining after the start of the normal 100 Club membership year will be charged a pro-rata amount for the rest of the year until April and entered in the next available draw following payment.
- 7. A member is eligible for inclusion in the draw so long as the subscription for that month has been paid.
- 8. Each member is allocated a permanent number in the monthly draw. This number shall remain the member's provided their subscription is up to date.
- 9. Members wishing to leave the 100 club should do so at the end of the club membership for that year. Refunds will not be given for people wishing to withdraw before the year end.
- 10. There shall be one prize draw per month. The draw for the preceding month will be made at the main committee meeting held on the first Thursday of each month. E.g. the winners for May will be drawn at the beginning of June.
- 11. Monthly prizes will be awarded according to membership of the 100 Club for that month as follows: 60% of the month's net payments shall make up the prize fund. 40% of that will be paid out each month as 2 equal prizes and 20% will be retained for an additional annual super draw in April (drawn at the May committee meeting). The remaining 40% will be retained for OBCC funds.
- The annual super draw will be held at the May meeting of the OBCC Committee in addition to the monthly draw. Only members who have been a member of the OBCC 100 Club for a minimum period of 6 months will be eligible for the annual super draw.
- 13. As an illustration, if we have 100 members of the OBBC 100 club, the two monthly prizes will be £100 each and the annual super draw will be £1,200.

- 14. The allocation of numbers and draw results will be available from the OBCC 100 club administrator on request and winners will be posted on the OBCC club notice board and on the OBCC web site
- 15. The 100 Club administrators will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a reasonable period after the monthly draw.
- 16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will deemed to have left the OBCC 100 Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the general funds of OBCC after 6 months.
- 17. The decision of the OBCC Main Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
- 18. The OBCC Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the OBCC 100 Club members as is necessary.
